As a vendor, you are responsible for securing all necessary permits and licenses.

- Please provide your **City of Reno Business License number**.
- If you do not have one, a one-day license is available for \$20.

Booth Details

• **Booth Space:** 10' x 10'

- Vendors must bring their own 6'-8' table, chairs, and optional canopy/tent
- Tents are not required, but the event is outdoors
- Canopies/tents may only be anchored with sandbags or water buckets (Stakes are not permitted)

Booth Décor & Sound

- Decorate your booth using tables, easels, sandwich boards, and signage
- All décor must be in good taste and must not interfere with neighboring vendors
- Jewish Nevada reserves the right to remove any materials deemed inappropriate or offensive
- Amplified music is not allowed (e.g., no boom boxes)

Code of Conduct & Liability

We expect all vendors to uphold the values of our community and event.

- No obscene behavior, crude language, or inappropriate actions will be tolerated
- Vendors not adhering to expectations may be asked to leave

Booth Fees are Non-Refundable

- Vendors will be contacted to confirm registration
- Vendors are responsible for cleaning their booth area immediately after the event
